2023's Rocky Mountain Mustang Roundup Mountain Tour begins driving across the prairie of southern Colorado, experiencing majestic views surrounding Canon City via a drive up Skyline Drive and conclude with a 50-mile mountain cruise up High Park Road of the Gold Belt Tour in to Cripple Creek. Zero out your trip odometer.	
Leave PPIR West parking lot for I-25 South towards Pueblo; enter I-25 South	0.5
Depart I-25 at Exit #101; US50 West towards Canon City (fuel & auto parts stores on right ~500 yards)	20.2
After you pass through Canon City make a right on Skyline Drive; go through stone arch. A wonderful opportunity to stop, where it's safe to, and take some pictures and walk around. Drive carefully – this all-paved scenic drive, built by inmate labor in 1905, is ~3 miles long with no guardrails, rising ~800 feet above the local terrain.	59.9
Leave Skyline Drive, make a right on to N. 5th Ave., continue and make a right at second stop sign	63.2
You're on Royal Gorge Blvd (also US50 West); right and into north parking lot for 8 Mile Bar & Grill (45000 W U.S. 50, Cañon City, CO 81212) for a break and lunch. Use north parking lot on left (through log entry overpass).	70.8
After lunch it's on to Cripple Creek! Right out of parking lot on US50 West to CO9 towards Cripple Creek; make a right. Enjoy Colorado's High Park Road of the Gold Belt Tour	72.2
Make another right on to Fremont/Teller County Road CR11 – feel free to stop, where it's safe, to take pictures and walk around.	80.8
Teller County CR11 makes another right on its way to Cripple Creek	99.2
At the 'T' make a right on Teller County Road 1 (CR1) towards Cripple Creek	103.2
Welcome to Cripple Creek, Colorado! Elevation 9,494 feet; hydrate and take it easy! You're on your own to find your lodging accommodation or explore as you wish. The RMMR Social begins at 6PM. Thank you for participating in the RMMR Mountain Tour	111.1
