



Rocky Mountain Mustang Roundup; Friday June 19, 2026, Mountain Tour

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO!

- **Arrive at Santa's Workshop (parking lot) by 9:30AM (5050 Pikes Peak Highway; Cascade, CO).**
- **Park your mustang as directed by our volunteers. The RMMR registrants need to exit their car and walk to the registration table.**
- **Pick up your packet and a Pikes Peak Highway map at the registration table.**
- **Place your vehicle number card in your windshield with the number facing outward.**
- **While waiting, review the map for bathroom locations, rest stops, food /gift shops and parking locations.**
- **If you want to drive the tour with other mustangers, you will need to stay in the same lane going through the Ranger station. Mustangs will be sent about 20 at a time.**
- **We'll launch in groups beginning at 9:50AM!**
- **Exit Santa's Workshop (parking lot), proceed south to the Pikes Peak Highway entry gate. Go to the gate on the far right, (Gate 3).**
- **The RMMR volunteers are going up the mountain at 10:15AM. If you arrive at Santa's Workshop (parking lot) after 10AM, you're on your own!**

General Information:

- **The weather will hopefully be great but if there are any concerns about road conditions on Pikes Peak call 719-385-7325 for the most up-to-date road conditions**
- **Expect 2-3 hours round trip for the drive plus whatever time you spend at rest stops and at the summit.**
- **The summit at Pikes Peak is at 14,115 feet! Hydrate and take it easy. Air is rare for both you and your mustang, especially if you are from lower altitudes.**
- **A forever Pikes Peak tradition are their donuts at the Summit House; really good!**
- **After the drive at Pikes Peak, you're on your own to make your way to Cripple Creek as we'll see you at the BBQ Hospitality Social Dinner starting at 5:00PM.**
